Linked to Aiman al-Zawahiri (Q1.A. 6.01) and the leadership of AQAP and the Organization of Al-Qaida in the Islamic Maghreb (AQIM) (QE. T. 14.01). Arrested and imprisoned multiple times by Egyptian authorities since ca. 2000. Released in 2011 but re-arrested by Egyptian authorities in Nov. 2012. Imprisoned in Egypt pending trial as of Sep. 2013. Wife's name is Samah 'Ali Al-Dahabani (Yemeni national).

MJN members were reported to be involved in the attack on the United States Mission in Benghazi, Libya, on 11 Spt. 2012.
