

FIU-Sri Lanka Celebrates the International FIU Day – June 09, 2026

On June 9, 2026, the Financial Intelligence Unit (FIU) of Sri Lanka proudly celebrated International FIU Day with an internal gathering at the Atrium of the Central Bank of Sri Lanka. This marked the first-ever International FIU Day, commemorating the founding of the Egmont Group at the Egmont Palace in Brussels in 1995 – a milestone that symbolizes global cooperation among FIUs in combating money laundering, terrorist financing, and other financial crimes.
